

# ADMISSION CRITERIA

(Last updated: March 2026)

## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

- By receiving the admission ticket, the visitor accepts and is subject to the venue regulations in their currently valid version.
- Instructions issued by security personnel, stewards and law enforcement authorities must be always followed.
- Access to and presence within the event area is permitted exclusively during the times specified by the organizer.
- Overnight stays or camping within the event area as well as in parking areas are not permitted.
- Visitors must remain on the designated paths.
- Standing or remaining on stairs and emergency escape routes is prohibited.
- Climbing over or sitting on fences/barriers is prohibited.
- Bringing animals onto the event premises is prohibited.

## 2. SECURITY & CONDUCT

- Persons who are visibly under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be granted access to the event area or may be removed from the premises, no entitlement to a refund of the admission price.
- Persons who do not comply with the venue regulations of the owner or who behave in a disruptive manner may be removed from the premises, no entitlement to a refund of the admission price.
- Visitors are informed that the event area is monitored by video surveillance and that these recordings may be used by law enforcement authorities for (criminal) prosecution against any visitor.

## 3. PHOTO, VIDEO & ADVERTISING RULES

- Photos, videos, audio recordings etc. are permitted exclusively for private, non-commercial use.
- The installation and display of posters anywhere within the event area, including the forecourt and parking areas, is only permitted with the express written approval of the owner or organizer.
- The distribution of advertising material is only permitted with prior written approval of the owner or organizer.

- Official merchandising items are sold within the event area. It is not permitted to purchase goods from unofficial vendors. Furthermore, the sale or distribution of any goods, whether for payment or free of charge, within the event area or on the parking areas is prohibited.

#### 4. NOISE NOTICE (MOTORSPORT)

- Motorsport events are loud.
- Visitors are responsible for wearing hearing protection during the event in order to reduce the risk of hearing damage. The organizer accepts no liability in this regard.
- It is recommended not to bring children under six years of age to motorsport events.

#### 5. FOOD & BEVERAGES

- Bringing cold food (snacks) is permitted exclusively for personal consumption.
- Bringing alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
- Beverages may only be brought in permitted containers:

##### **Permitted:**

- Plastic bottles
- Standard beverage cans
- Thermos bottles / flasks (Stanley Cup) up to a maximum of 1.5 liters

##### **Not permitted:**

- Glass bottles or other breakable containers
- Thermos bottles / flasks (Stanley Cup) exceeding 1.5 liters
- Cooling boxes

### LIST OF PROHIBITED ITEMS

Spectators are prohibited from bringing objects of any kind that can be thrown or shot, or that could otherwise disturb or endanger the peace, order, and safety of the event site. This applies, but not exclusively, to the items listed below:

- Electronic devices (computers, tablets, E-Book-Reader, power banks larger than mobile phones or similar devices)

- Beverage containers in the form of glass and other breakable bottles (except unbreakable plastic bottles and commercially available cans)
- Thermos flasks larger than 1.5 liters
- Barbecues, cookers and other appliances for preparing food
- Weapons of any kind and objects having an effect similar to weapons, such as knives, darts, etc.
- Articles and objects that can be used as weapons or projectiles, in particular metal objects such as detachable chains, iron bars and pieces of iron
- Laser pointers of all kinds
- Pyrotechnic articles of all kinds; in general, the bringing in of fireworks, smoke bombs, incendiary devices, sticks, poles, garden and other large umbrellas, glass bottles, stones, stabbing, cutting and slashing objects as well as weapons of all kinds is prohibited
- Parasols in the seating area
- Drugs and stimulants
- Racist, xenophobic, radical right-wing, national socialist, sexist or political propaganda material
- (Domestic) animals
- Gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable, coloring substances or containers with substances that may affect health or are easily flammable
- Bulky objects such as scaffolding, ladders, bicycles, skateboards, (electric) scooters, segways, hand or scooter carts, electric vehicles, and baby strollers
- For access to the grandstands, bulky or large bags, large backpacks, suitcases, sports bags, camera tripods and selfie sticks are prohibited. Bulky items within the meaning of this provision are all pieces of luggage larger than DIN A3 that cannot be stored within the ticket seat area.
- Beach shells, tents, pagodas or similar structures and constructions.
- The use of unmanned equipment (e.g. drones) or model aircraft/unmanned aerial vehicles is strictly prohibited on the entire grounds.
- Cooling boxes
- all kind of alcoholic beverages

## LIST OF PERMITTED ITEMS

- Mobile phones, power banks not larger than mobile phones.
- Cameras, film and video cameras with batteries for private use and NOT for commercial purposes (e.g. NO video cameras suitable for television)
- Canes for the blind, walking aids
- Key rings, purse chain
- Medicines for personal use
- Flagpoles up to 1.6 m and less than 2 cm in diameter, in general, access to the stands may be denied if flagpoles are brought along.
- Commercially available pocket lighters
- Binoculars
- Compact sun umbrellas and umbrellas in the standing-room area
- Folding chairs and folding armchairs in the standing area
- Plastic bottles and beverage cans
- Thermos flasks (Stanley Cup) not larger than 1.5 liters
