Austria's biggest sporting event of the year (27th - 29th June) is once again set to be an extravaganza of entertainment. Contested by the world's motorsport elite, the Formula 1 home race of the Oracle Red Bull Racing team will also feature a variety of unique side events. These include the Legends Parade, autograph sessions with the world championship drivers and live concerts. There will be an emotion-packed atmosphere throughout the entire Grand Prix site. Legends Parade: Celebrating the fascination of movie cars. The Austrian Formula 1 Grand Prix has a distinct Hollywood feel to it in 2025. To coincide with the premiere of 'F1® The Movie', one of the original race cars of the APXGP team, driven by Brad Pitt, will join the automotive Hollywood stars at Spielberg. Under the billing of 'Movie Cars', hot rods from the dream factory and TV classics will revive emotions and memories at the Legends Parade. On display in the somewhat incongruous setting of the Austrian Alps will be mostly original film vehicles, such as the Aston Martin DB5 driven by James Bond actor Sean Connery in 'Goldfinger', the 1968 Ford Mustang from the cult movie 'Bullitt' starring Steve McQueen and the 1967 Ford Mustang 'Eleanor' driven by Nicolas Cage in 'Gone in 60 Seconds', as well as several memorable cars from the 'Fast & Furious' series. Iconic racing cars, which became the main characters in films along with their drivers, such as Niki Lauda's 1975 Ferrari 312T and the 1976 Ferrari 312T2 from the film 'Rush', are star attractions in the line-up. But it's not only four-wheeled showpieces that will be lapping the Red Bull Ring circuit: also there will be the Kawasaki GPz 900R Ninja made famous by Tom Cruise in 'Top Gun'. The legendary bike will do a few laps of the Grand Prix circuit together with its 'co-star', a Porsche 356 Speedster. All the vehicles will also be on display in the F1 Fan Zone, including the A-Team van and the Dodge Charger "Generarl Lee" from 'The Dukes of Hazzard'.
