Under the title "Movie Cars", the Red Bull Legends Parade is adding a touch of Hollywood glamour at Spielberg during the Austrian GP. Many big names from Tinseltown and TV classics will spark emotions and a wealth of memories among fans. The illustrious line-up at the steering wheels of the bolides steeped in history is widely anticipated every year. The starting field is also Hollywoodstyle and is now definite. "Movie Cars" and the F1 legends in the cockpits. In 2025, the premier class of motorsports is infused by Hollywood. "F1® The Movie" with Brad Pitt is currently celebrating its premiere. It is therefore fitting that two of the original racing cars from the film can be seen at Spielberg as part of the Red Bull Legends Parade. The Formula 1 bolide of the fictitious APXGP team is exhibited in the F1 Fan Zone and Mark Webber will rev up the Porsche GT3-R from the film at the Red Bull Ring. The British F1 star David Coulthard was simply made to sit in the original film vehicle from "Goldfinger", the Aston Martin DB5 with all the technical finesse of a James Bond from the year 1964. There are only a handful of Austrians who can do Niki Lauda proud in the Ferrari 312T from the film "Rush" - one of them is no doubt Gerhard Berger.

Stars from films, TV, YouTube and sports at the wheel. The F1 TV expert dream team Alexander Wurz and Ernst Hausleitner, alternating with the Styrian governor Mario Kunasek, will deliver a dual in two Bullitt bolides. The Sunrise Avenue frontman Samu Haber is piloting the Dodge Charger "General Lee", while Elton is at the wheel of the Plymouth Hemi Cuda from "Fast & Furious". Marcel Hirscher and Timo Glock will give their all in the Ford Mustang "Eleanor" from "Gone in 60 Seconds". The bike artist Fabio Wibmer, Andrea Schlager, Christian Klien and the creator "Austriankiwi" Jonny Balchin will have fun in further "Fast & Furious" icons. The Tatort star Richy Müller is returning in his film Porsche 911 Targa and Gregor Bloeb as the only biker is launching himself onto a Kawasaki GPz 900R Ninja, which was catapulted to fame with Tom Cruise. "Top Gun" is also the motto for Nina Proll, who will open the throttle of the Porsche 356 Speedster at the Red Bull Ring.
