On 14th July 2025, Austrian motorcycle legend Gustl Auinger proudly announced the addition of the Red Bull Legends Parade to the support programme of the MotoGP weekend. The local hero will be joined by numerous motorcycle racing idols as they lap the Red Bull Ring on racing machines that last contested major prizes several decades ago. The circuit will be transformed into a seething cauldron of motorcycle history. This new event is guaranteed to bring back many fond memories and to tap into a rich seam of emotion. Red Bull Legends Parade brings back a whiff of two-stroke magic from days gone by. In a preview of the Red Bull Legends Parade at Spielberg, Gustl Auinger unveiled a Yamaha YZR 500 with a very special pedigree: it was the machine on which New Zealander Simon Crafar secured a win in the 1998 British Grand Prix at Donington Park, for the first time sporting Red Bull livery. At the 2025 Austrian Grand Prix, numerous legends of two-wheel racing will be putting in a few laps of the Red Bull Ring, some riding their own bikes from back then, some astride historic racing machines associated with other greats of the sport. Fans will be carried away by motorcycle nostalgia as they immerse themselves in the roar of 500cc engines and the whiff of two-stroke magic from yesteryear.

World champions, double, triple, five-time world champions and... Giacomo Agostini.
